

UNIFORM POLICY

Boys and Girls - everyday uniform

Polo-style shirts (short or long sleeve)



Long-sleeved undershirts can be worn in the same color as the top.

Pants or knee-length shorts Girls may also wear skorts or skirts.



Leggings can be worn in the same color as the bottom.

- 1. Pants must fit properly at the waist, not saggy or dragging. No denim (jean) or stretchy (legging) material.
- 2. Shirts must be long enough to fall below waistline.
- 3. Shorts, skorts, and skirts should not be shorter than 2 inches from the top of the knee.
- 4.Only closed-toed shoes. Tennis shoes needed for PE.
- 5. Hair should be well groomed, neatly styled, and a natural hair color. Refrain from extremes in style trends.
- 6. No head coverings in the school building no hats, bandanas, hoodies on, or scarves.
- 7.No jewelry except medical alert items.
- 8. One wrist band with Christian theme or medical cause may be worn.
- 9. Make-up should be modest. Nail polish should be well maintained, clean, and neat. Acceptable color and design will be at the discretion of administration and staff.
- 10.Belts, if worn, must be plain, and in either black or brown.

School approved outerwear with school name or logo is acceptable. Outerwear does not need the school patch and may have a small, brand name or logo in the lapel area.
